

What is Grantfinder?

Grantfinder is a comprehensive database of UK and EU funding initiatives, ranging from grants and loans to advisory schemes.

It comprises in total around 2000 individual reports, updated on a monthly basis, providing information on over 4000 programmes covering criteria, eligibility, application procedures and deadlines.

You can search for funding for a specific project you have in mind, search for a particular funder or you can search the reports for a particular word or phrase.

How Can I Access Grantfinder?

Grantfinder is available at NVS at the Charing Cross Centre for reference at the following times:

Monday to Friday 10 am to 4 pm

Please book ahead to make sure Grantfinder is free, as it is our most used resource. Appointments outside the opening times may also be available. To make an appointment please telephone NVS on 01603 614474.

We aim to provide a service tailored to the needs of users - some may require detailed assistance while others may require only a brief explanation of how Grantfinder works. An average Grantfinder search session takes about 30 minutes, but you should allow up to 2 hours to read through the information and to print off your identified funders.

- What the money will be used for
- The kind of people who will benefit
